## Financial News

Greenwyche Club's current balance as of the end of April 2011 is \$54,349.95. We recently made a \$15,000 payment to 1<sup>st</sup> Commercial Bank for the loan taken out to redo the medium-sized pool. Our outstanding balance is now approximately \$60,000. We hope to pay off the loan in the next few years.

Currently 14 families still owe the pool assessment fee from last October. All outstanding fees must be paid before the pool opens on May 25, 2011. All summer dues payments made now must include a \$50 late fee, so regular members should pay \$475 and senior members should pay \$375. Since the due date is past, it is best if you hand-deliver the check to me, Lynne Reynolds, at 4029 Lucerne Drive. If I am not at home, please place the payment under my front door mat and send me an e-mail letting me know that it is there. Help minimize the need for follow up calls by paying your fees as soon as possible! **Remember, no 2011 membership cards will be issued until fees are paid and a 2011 Health form is on file.**
